All honest brokers are required to complete a set of training material/sessions.

All training must be renewed at specified intervals and documentation of completion provided to the VCUHS Compliance Office for honest brokers to maintain active status.

Wright Center honest broker data analysts must complete additional Epic training prior to being granted access to the Enterprise Data Warehouse.

## 6. Procedures

### Initial Training

The following training material/sessions must be completed and documentation of completion provided to the VCUHS Compliance Office ([complianceservices@vcuhealth.org](mailto:complianceservices@vcuhealth.org)) prior to personnel being approved to function as an Honest broker.

- Information Security Awareness

- Information Security
- Annual Patient Privacy Training

#### CITI

- Basic/Refresher Course Human Subjects Research - Biomedical
- Information Privacy Security (IPS) - Health Privacy (HIPAA)

- Information Privacy Security (IPS) - Information Security

- Personal Honest broker onboarding session

## Supplemental Data Analyst Training

Honest broker data analysts may also receive access to the Snowflake Enterprise Data Warehouse and the Clarity/Caboodle databases on SQL Server. The prerequisites for access to each data source are listed below.

### **Snowflake VCU\_RESEARCH\_DB (MDAS, OMOP)**

- Completion of *Initial Training* described above

### **Snowflake DATALAKE\_PROD\_DB and SQL Server (Clarity, Caboodle)**

- Completion of *Initial Training* described above
- Completion of Cogito Fundamentals (COG170) certification/accreditation

New honest broker data analysts should enroll in the next available Clarity Data Model (CLR110) and Caboodle Data Model (CDW110) courses after completing COG170.

## Ongoing Training

In order to maintain their status, honest brokers must renew the following trainings at the specified intervals.

- VCU Talent - annual
- VCUHS Workday - annual
- CITI - every two years
- Honest broker training sessions led by the VCUHS Compliance Office (quarterly)
